

Friends of Parker River National Wildlife Refuge

Board of Directors Meeting Tuesday, Aug. 20, 2024 7:00 p.m. Remote via Zoom

- I. Call to Order. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by President Ted Olsson.
- II. Secretary's Report. The minutes of the July 16 Board meeting were accepted. A review of action items showed that some had been completed or were in process and some needed to be carried over as action items.
- III. Refuge Staff Update: Matt Hillman congratulated Ella Weber on two awards. She was named Visitor Services Manager of the Year, a regional honor, and has received a Spark award, a national level honor. Ella congratulated Matt on being chosen Refuge Manager of the Year, a regional award. The Board will send official letters of congratulations to Matt and Ella. Matt also reported that expenses for the demolition of the Pink House will not come from the Parker River budget.

Ella reported as follows.

- *The environmental ed. position is open and being advertised.
- *The administrative assistant (front desk) position should be filled by Nov.
- *The Friends slide show is being updated. (Ella sent a copy with a request for better quality photos, if available.)

- *Thanks for camper snacks. Ella requested snacks for the Housing Authority program. Lynette and Ella will discuss.
- *Ella will be gone from Sept. 1 until the end of Oct.

- *Volunteers are needed for vegetation management, framing new entrance signs, and for salt marsh restoration.
- IV. Treasurer's Report: Lynette reported that our financial picture is good. A donation in excess of \$3,000 has come in and is to be used as needed. It could lead to a match from the donor's employer. Due to non-renewals membership is down. Renewals have not been possible online this summer and Lynette is still working with PayPal to resolve this problem. When time permits she will work on writing protocols for the treasurer.
